

Frasier to Provide Grant Funding to Area Agencies

Boulder, CO: June 23, 2023Frasier, a Boulder retirement community, awarded grants to six local agencies offering essential services to older adults in Boulder County. Funds totaling \$120,000 for these organizations are provided through the Frasier Community Resource Fund Endowment that was established as part the Frasier's social responsibility efforts.

Seniors for Seniors, an advisory committee comprised of Frasier residents, provides stewardship of the endowment, valued at \$2.1 million. The committee spent several months researching the unmet needs of seniors in Boulder County and learning what non-profit organizations are doing to help overcome funding challenges. Seniors for Seniors members established the grant criteria, reviewed proposals, and visited each organization to better understand their mission and how they might use grants.
