



Frasier to Provide Grant Funding to Area Agencies

Boulder, CO: Frasier, a Boulder retirement community, held a check presentation in June, 2022, for five local organizations offering essential services to older adults in Boulder County. Funds, totaling \$75,000, going to these agencies were provided through the Frasier Community Resource Fund Endowment that was established as part the Frasier's social responsibility efforts.

Seniors for Seniors, an advisory committee comprised of Frasier residents, provide stewardship of the endowment, valued at \$2.1 million. The committee spent nearly eight months researching the unmet needs of seniors in Boulder County and learning what non-profit organizations are doing to help overcome funding challenges. Seniors for Seniors members established the grant criteria, reviewed proposals, and visited each organization to better understand their mission and how they might use grants.

The following organizations are the inaugural recipients of the Frasier Community Resource Fund:

- **Boulder Housing Partners Foundation (\$20,000)**
- **Boulder County Area Agency on Aging (\$15,000)**
- **City of Boulder Older Adult Services (\$15,000)**
- **Friends of Longmont Senior Center (\$15,000)**
- **City of Louisville Senior Services (\$10,000)**

Going forward, the Frasier Seniors for Seniors committee will annually distribute funds to area non-profit senior service organizations through grant submissions and a diligent selection process.
